CP Learning Trust was founded in 2003 from the learning partnerships of Cambridgeshire and Peterborough. From 2001-2003 we delivered skills for life across the county, raising awareness and encouraging individuals to improve their literacy and numeracy skills. (Maths and English). We now include lifelong learning and are working to improve the skills of adults across the county.

We are a not for profit charitable organisation, based in Chatteris, Cambridgeshire.

We look for funding from central government and regional agencies to support our work in the county, and are a completely **independent** organisation working for the benefit of the individual concerned.



Why do we do it?

Our Vision: where every individual has the opportunity to improve their life through learning.

CP Learning Trust believes that all individuals have the right to equality in learning opportunity, wherever possible funded and local, delivered in a way that supports and encourages those with fewer skills to access those opportunities.

What do we do?

CP Learning Trust works with potential learners to encourage and promote learning in the community, through first step activities to longer courses. We have helped over 35,000 learners in the past eight years.

We help people overcome barriers to learning and achieve their potential, providing progression routes to further learning through partnership locally, and encourage residents to volunteer to promote learning in their own communities. Training and supporting new groups dedicated to improving opportunities in their area.

Wherever possible we offer courses free in the community we are working in, and encourage other providers to deliver in the area.
